C18th George III period mahogany circular 'snap-top' tripod base tea table on carved pillar column. The thick single piece figured mahogany top raised on a wrythen carved and turned column stem with a central wrythen-carved vase knop. The shapely carved tripod legs with pad feet. Fitted with a brass 'banjo' catch to underside of top to allow the table to tip when required, the block set with a brass 'keeper'. In fresh-to-market, as found, countryhouse condition, the top having some historic marks and stains commensurate with age, use and purpose. The original polished surface having achieved a rich colour and patina. No breaks, damage or repairs. H 31" D 28" W 28" England c. 1760
