Internally two glass shelves and the base allowing further display. Both with working locks and keys. Original makers label, 'Rurka' to back. Joseph (or Joe) Rurka was born in about 1890 in Berdichev, Ukraine. His father supplied timber to carpenters. He left his six brothers, one sister and parents in about 1910 and came to London, England, where he married Eva (nee Hirsh) where he had a small furniture factory in London's East End.
