The single-domed top and use of richly figured burr walnut veneers showcase both elegance and precision, indicative of early Georgian furniture design. The upper section features an arched single-door cabinet with the original bevelled mirror plate above a candle slide. The door opens to reveal adjustable shelves, perfect for displaying books or valuables. The top is accentuated by finely turned finials, enhancing its classical proportions. The fall-front bureau opens to reveal a well-fitted interior, with a series of small drawers, pigeonholes, and central compartments for documents and stationery. Below the writing slope, there are four graduated cockbeaded and feather-banded drawers with original brass handles and escutcheons. An unusual feature is the neatly concealed brushing slide, stowed just below the top drawer. Materials: Constructed primarily in burr walnut with a rich, warm pati...
