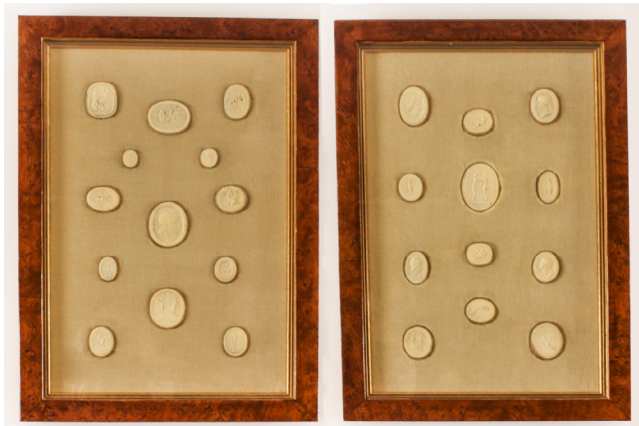

Though primarily associated with the British nobility and wealthy landed gentry, similar trips were made by wealthy young men of Protes...
