Signed 'Swiss made' to 6 o'clock. A gold capped case with shaped lugs, extending from the central case body. An Omega winding crown. The back has a central medallion, showing the Constellation line logo of the Geneva Observatory. Case reference 2762 1 SC. The watch is powered by a 17 jewel caliber 354 Omega mechanism. The 14m serial numbers date this watch to 1954. The watch comes complete with its leather-bound box, specifically designed for the Constellation line.
