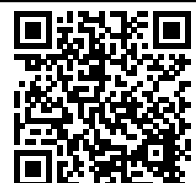
Dating to the late 19th or early 20th century, this delicate, slim ebony stick conceals a stiletto blade rather than a sword, the crook handle is bone and the mounts are gilded. There are some marks on the mount which are difficult to decipher "B?P" which may be Britannia Gold Plate.
