Antique Victoria Austria coffee cup and saucer set for 5 persons. This unique set of six coffee cups with matching saucers, crafted from fine, translucent porcelain, dates back to the early 20th century, when the Victoria Austria porcelain company was thriving. The cups feature gilded patterns against a rose-coloured background, with three distinct designs showcasing images of two grouse. The saucers are adorned with hand-painted, multicoloured butterflies, adding a vibrant and artistic touch to the set. A fascinating detail of this set is the gold anchor mark on the cups and saucers, traditionally associated with the Chelsea porcelain company, which ceased operations in 1769 (though the mark was used until 1775 by Chelsea-Derby). One cup also bears a partially concealed Victoria mark, covered with a rose motif and accompanied by the Chelsea mark. The design, including the shape of the handles, layout of the decoration, and overall patterns, emulates the Chelsea style. This set is a likely one-of-a-kind piece for Victoria Austria porcelain collectors, offering a valuable addition to any serious antique porcelain collection.
