An English silver plated on copper pair of twin branch candelabra, each bearing the maker's mark of the renowned silversmith, Elkington & Co, circa 1920 in date. The central columns are fluted with stiff-leaf knops to the top and bottom and the circular bases have gadroon borders. They have twisted fluted arms on the capitals of the three lights candles with detachable sconce nozzles. A stunning pair of candelabra. The firm was founded by George Richards Elkington and his brother, Henry Elkington, in the 1830s. It operated under the name G. R. Elkington & Co. until 1842, when a third partner, Josiah Mason, joined the firm. It operated as Elkington, Mason, & Co. until 1861, when the partnership with Mason was terminated. The firm operated independently as Elkington & Co. from 1861 until 1963. It was then taken over by British Silverware, Ltd. In 1971 British Silverware, Ltd. became a subsidiar...

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
