The round, squat baluster bodies are embossed with a fluted design, raised on four ball feet, and trimmed with gadrooned borders. The teapot boasts a domed ogee lid with a lobed button finial and an ornate moulded scroll handle, capped with an acanthus design. The cream jug and sugar basin interiors are sumptuously gold-washed, adding an extra touch of elegance. Each piece features a pair of oval vacant cartouches, making this tea set ideal for engraving as a gift.
