The slim proportioned case with architectural pediment to the top, moulded edge to the trunk and turned cistern cover to the base. Silvered scale hygrometer to the top with remote adjustment knob set below, matching engraved silvered scale to the barometer with vernier marker set to the side and mercury action barometer tube to the centre. Very rare full length mercury action thermometer to the trunk with engraved silvered scale and brass guard to the thermometer cistern. A fine quality instrument fully serviced and working, presented in superb condition with a deep polish to the case. Keep up to date via Instagram - sturmansantiques.
