DOMINATED BY THREE JOINED CENTRAL ELONGATED HEXAGONAL MEDALLIONS AND MATCHING SPANDRELS AND HALF MEDALLIONS. This design appears to have been chiefly used by the Basseri. It occurs in combination with a number of different border solutions (see examples in literature). .
