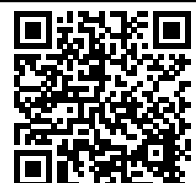

The table is supported by three cabriole legs with concave caps or lappets to the top of the legs, this design found on earlier models. This table is in very good condition for age, is of stable construction and can go straight into a home.
