Description

Mid 19th.c. Biedermeier style secretaire abattant or writing bureau in unusual pale birch burr c.1840. Open the fall to form a good sized desk (height 31") with a green leather writing surface, held steady on curving brass brackets. Fitted interior in flame mahogany with a long drawer and open bookshelf over five small drawers plus two secret compartments opening with hidden sprung catches. Original grey marble top, a frieze drawer above the bureau and three more drawers below. Highly figured birch burr veneers arranged in a symmetrical pattern across the front and sides to striking effect. Gilded brass handles and escutcheons. Raised on a moulded plinth and shaped bracket feet, also veneered to match. Oak drawer linings and back panels. Very good condition, cleaned and waxed in our workshops.
