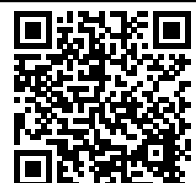

With the lid open, the interior reveals two stamp reservoirs which are curved for ease of stamp removal. A wonderful example, also giving alternative use as a paperweight.
