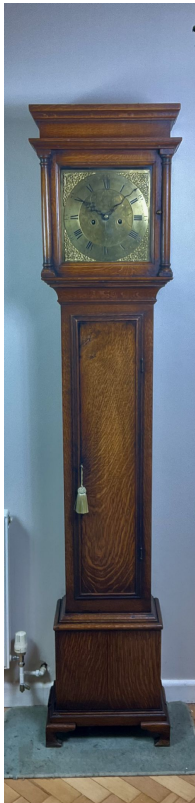

Width 44cm at base and 45cm at Hood Depth 23.25cm at Base and 25cm at Hood The Hood with Cushion Top and Columns which Form Part of the Hood Door in the Late 17th Early 18th Century Preference. The Glass to the Hood Door is Old with Air Bubbles and Is Probably Original.
