Standing on simple bun feet. The quality of materials used throughout and the fine standard of construction leaves no doubt that these pieces were produced in one of the leading workshops of the period, probably in Paris. Pairs of commodes are always sought-after and this particular pair are of desirable size and stand beautifully.
