This is an ornate antique temple gong. A Burmese, carved teak mounted chime, dating to the late Victorian period, circa 1900. Exceptional Far Eastern decoration to this ornate gong. Displays a desirable aged patina and in good order. Teak crafted into a fine example of pierced fretwork. Deep russet hues to the profuse vine motif, mask and dragon detailing. Centrally mounted gong, suspended to the rear upon leather straps. Hand-beaten brass with a deep golden hue and a diameter of 19cm (7.5"). Striker resides in the hand of a fascinating carved figure to the shaped base. Presents a prominent, metallic tone when struck. This is a fascinating antique temple gong, with superb craftsmanship to the distinctive frame. Delivered ready to display or use.
