Quality needlepoint set within a shield-shaped frame. Riser pole adorned with a small carved finial, set within a brass collar. Distinctive frame, pinched to corners and centre with scroll shell relief. Panel embroidered with a foliate bouquet, in subtle pastel hues. Dressed to rear with light yellow silk cotton, accentuated with brocade trim. Adjustable screen height, can be set within a range of 83cm (32.75"). Moves up and down upon a pair of sliding brass collars. Pole set within a tapering gadrooned mount above a striking petal base. Standing upon a trio of shaped bracket feet with turned-up toes.
