Rope twist decoration to the base and capitals with conforming shell cornered square shaped removable sconces. Present on the base of each is a small engraving of a previous owner's insignia and each candlestick is marked to the underside for London 1754 by John Café and the capitals are also marked with maker's mark and lion passant (rubbed). In excellent condition with no damage or repairs (see condition report below), these fabulous 270-year-old Silver Candlesticks would look stunning in any setting and would greatly enhance any silver collection.
