Available for sale from Big Sky Fine Art in the English county of Dorset, this original painting is by the Nottinghamshire artist Thomas Cooper Moore and dates from around the 1880s. The watercolour is presented and supplied in a sympathetic frame and mount (which is shown in these photographs) and behind glass dating from about the 1980s. There is evidence of an old fold in the paper that runs vertically through the right-hand structure of the castle. This has been virtually eliminated by pressure and gentle heat in a press, addressed in the 1980s when the artwork was framed. This piece is now ready to hang and display. The watercolour is signed lower left. Good News for our US Customers!
