A rare pair of Georgian silver bottle tickets. These wonderful pieces are rectangular in shape, with a reeded border and squared corners. The words 'Chili Vinegar' are engraved to the centre of one and 'Worcester' to the other. The labels are supported on belcher chains and the titles are in 'pricked' initials. Large Georgian cruets contained many small bottles of sauces and condiments and these unusual examples are particularly interesting. The spelling of Chili with one 'L' is rather rare and denotes the Georgian time period. Unusual collector's pieces, decorative and practical. Dimensions below.
