Fascinating scroll shield back with prominent surmount. Back rest with oval medallion and finished with an enamelled crest. Sporting eagle winds, the scroll in Latin translating to 'Freedom through Law'. Shaped seat squab set at a comfortable height of 43cm (17"). Tall cabriole front legs, with relief scroll to the knee over a scrolled toe. Rear legs gently splayed with square section feet. This is a fascinating antique law chambers hall chair, offering gorgeous colour and a distinctive Rococo form. Solid joints and construction, delivered ready for the home.
