Description

This antique porcelain scent bottle was crafted by the Thieme Potschappel Dresden factory around 1902. The piece showcases an oriental-inspired design, featuring bird motifs and intricate floral decorations. Gold accents on the finial and edges enhance its luxurious appeal. The form is influenced by the designs of Johann Stadler (1701-1741) from Meissen, blending 18th-century tradition with early 20th-century innovation. The bottle exemplifies the exceptional craftsmanship of Thieme Potschappel Dresden artisans, renowned for their ability to merge modern aesthetics with historical influences. The underside bears the underglazed blue company mark, along with the incised numbers 2991 and 52 in gold. These pieces are highly sought after by collectors of Dresden porcelain. Carl Thieme, a distinguished porcelain modeler, was born in 1838 in Potschappel, near Dresden. He began his career at the Meissen Porcelain Manufactory in 1856, where he refined his craft under the guidance of expert artisans. In 1872, he founded the Carl Thieme Porcelain Manufactory in Potschappel, specializing in finely detailed porcelain figures, vases, and decorative objects. Known for their vibrant col...
