Retains the original cut-glass oil reservoir below the bulb and shade holders, having previously been sympathetically converted from an oil-lamp to electricity. In excellent condition with no damage to the glass and only minor wear and rubbing to the gilded surfaces commensurate with age, use and purpose. A strikingly-coloured glass lamp to add extravagance and flamboyance to an interior scheme. Can be re-wired to client's specifications.
