A small early 18th century English queen anne period jewellery chest, constructed from oak and veneered in burr walnut. The chest consists of 7 drawers around a central door with compartment behind, the form of the chest is very much designed and based on the late 17thC - early 18th century bureau, which many were veneered in walnut, yew and other figurative timbers. The little table chest has a lovely surface patina with rich orange, red and brown hues, and it is in excellent condition and ready to put your keepsakes in.
