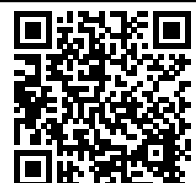
To come across such a narrow antique runner, never mind a Baluch runner these days, only 52cm wide, is truly a rare find! Made by Baluch tribes in the Zabol area of Sistan Province, south-east Persia circa 1880, this runner is in excellent overall condition and ready to lay in a narrow hallway. The glowing brown-red ground is divided into nine Turkmen 'tshemtshe' guls, often used by the Sistani Baluch in their weavings. Particularly attractive, is the use of a beautiful green in the inner and outer borders as well as being complete with its flatweave and brocaded skirts each end. Size: 3.05m x 0.52m (10' 0" x 1' 8").
