The movement and dial is suspended below the portico between the four Doric columns. The large faux temperature compensating pendulum swings below. The magnificent dial is modelled in ormolu with a deep bezel of acanthus and lotus leaves and engine turned centre. The top has an ogee moulded cornice and a frieze of flowing cornucopia and pieced anthemions. The base is applied with cornucopia and flowing stems. It sits on engine turned bun feet.
