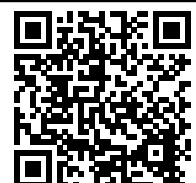

On a visit to Wensleydale in 1910 with George Graham, they decided to settle there and shared a studio for several years. Fred married the young Muriel Metcalfe of Leyburn in 1933, who was also a painter. Exhibited at the R.A., R.I. and at numerous exhibitions of Yorkshire artists.
