The top bears inscription Made Birmingham "B" 1825 Cased in original Moroccan leather box Original gilding in great condition Height 2.5cm Width 7cm Weight 88.4 grams. In 1825, Nathaniel Mills registered his punch mark "N.M" in a rectangle at the Birmingham Assay Office. This marked the beginning of his work as a solo silversmith. Mills was a prolific box maker in Birmingham who created silver and gold objects, including vinaigrettes, card cases, and snuff boxes. His work is known for its castle-top designs, which feature British landmarks engraved on the lids.
