Size in inches: H 7.5 x W 8" x D 4" Origin: Unknown Date: late 19th Century Condition: Aged A naturally aged item that has stood the test of time, worn surface resulting is loss of sections of detail such as one of the feet and hands on the man figure. Long gone aged worm holes are present which do not cause any structural damage or fragility to this object. Its firmly in place and supported by the base.
