Note the wonderful intensity and richness of the colours. The outstanding red is so delicious and variegated and is complemented by delightful light blues, sapphire blues, greens, pinks and golds. The medallion design is also finely rendered, and feels both primitive and very contemporary at the same time. The stylised floral border is also exceptional and forms the perfect frame for the dynamic field.
