An absolutely stunning piece of Walnut was used to create this large jewelry box dating to around 1860, Victorian in era. There is a highly decorative shield shaped cartouche to the top with a complimentary escutcheon, both made from Mother of Pearl, which houses the tasselled key, unfortunately for decorative purposes only as it currently is not working. The large interior has been professionally re-lined in a hand marbled paper creating a fresh and clean interior ready to use. There is a brass button at the back which when pressed releases the spring-loaded drawer with it's vibrant purple velvet lining, perfect for those delicate pieces of jewellery or wrist watches. The interior of the lid is lined in velvet with a spring next to the lid lock which when pushed releases the lid and reveals a travel mirror on the reverse side. Excellent condition and an impressive size, measuring 12" x 9" x 7" with a rich glossy patina showcasing the stunning markings of this highly prized timber. Item ID: 33087
