We have identified the maker or pattern but believe to be either Minton or Maw and Co and typically around 1870, possibly a bespoke client design for an architectural project, with emphasis towards the Aesthetic. A wall hanging or desk, table top against a wall, bookcase display etc., a rare and wonderful group that appeal both artistically as they do fine 19th century reclamation, a great architectural study piece. Dimensions Square 36cm Depth 3cm It's possible to be certain these are floor and not wall tiles by the thickness of the frame and the weight, apx 10kg tbc.
