Antique Victorian quality carved mahogany display cabinet by James Winter & Sons having an unusual polished mahogany top with a carved edge above a pair of quality carved mahogany astral glazed doors opening to reveal three adjustable display shelves. The base having a polished mahogany top with a carved edge above two drawers with reeded decoration and stamped by James Winter & Sons, original brass handles standing on square tapering carved mahogany legs with unusual block feet united by a shaped mahogany undertier. A beautifully crafted example by the renowned cabinet makers James Winter & Sons who were based in Soho London between 1823 to 1870 and produced some amazing pieces of antique furniture. James Winter founded his company in 1823 as a cabinet maker, undertaker, dealer, appraiser and specialised as a restorer of second hand and antique furniture to retail in his Soho shop. His sons joined his firm and then the business was renamed James Winter & Sons, 101 Wardour St., Soho, London. It was throughout the Regency and Victorian period, James Winters Company flourished with stunning new designs and beautifully crafted, restored furniture retailed to their Victori...
