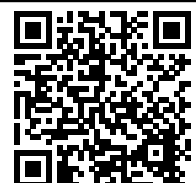
Description

A particularly well coloured, impressionistic and sensitively rendered oil on paper study of a female nude. The attractive subject is seen from behind and positioned next to an easel in the artists studio. This fine and highly decorative work is attributed to celebrated British artist Ronald Ossory Dunlop. Ronald Ossory DUNLOP (1894-1973) Ronald Ossory Dunlop was born in Dublin in 1894. His mother, Eleanor Dunlop (Fitzpatrick) was a watercolour artist and his father, Daniel Nicol Dunlop (1868-1935), was a great friend of W. B. Yeats, James Stephens and George Russell. The young Ronald Ossory grew up surrounded by the seminal figures of the Irish Literary Renaissance, in an atmosphere that smacked peculiarly of mysticism and spiritualism. The Dunlop family moved to New York in 1899, then London three years later. From here, they made the annual pilgrimage back to Dublin during Horse Show week, with Dunlop's father returning to London clutching two or three more canvasses each time. Dunlop trained in art in London, associating with a group of young artists who all exhibited at the Hurricane Lamp Gallery in Chelsea. In 1928 the group published a journal called Emotionalism,...
