Albert Robert Quinton 1853-1934. English watercolour artist known for his paintings of British villages and landscapes, many of which were published as postcards. Quinton studied painting at the Heatherley School of Fine Art. From 1877 he exhibited watercolours at the Royal Society British Artists. Many of his artworks were published as postcards by Raphael Tuck and J. Salmon Ltd which remain popular with today's collectors. His paintings have been published in many calendars. Well over 2000 of his paintings were published between 1904 and the time of his death. He also illustrated a number of books including 'The Historic Thames' by Hillaire Belloc. He exhibited at the Birmingham Royal Society of British Artists; Dudley Gallery; Dowdeswell Gallery; Grosvenor Gallery; Walker Art Gallery, Liverpool; Manchester City Art Gallery; the Royal Society of British Artists; Royal Hibernian Academy; Royal Institute of Painters in Watercolour and the Royal Institute of Oil Painters. He exhibited at the Royal Academy but he was later banned...
