A super quality double sided mahogany Victorian apothecary box from Savory & Moore, New Bond Street. The box opens with double doors at the front which reveal the medicine bottles - most of which are original to Savory & Moore. There is a drawer in the front which is for other medical pieces. There is a brass inset carrying handle on top of the box. The museum of Melbourne purchased the entire contents of Savory & Moore when the shop finally closed. The museum shipped it over and then set it up as it would have looked in New Bond Street. The box has it's original maker's plaque - It reads: Prize Medal 1862 - 'Chemists to the Queen, 143 New Bond Street, London'
