This is a fabulous monumental antique Old Sheffield plate silver on copper entree dish and cover, circa 1810 in date. The dish is of an unusual large size and rectangular in shape with a detachable cast handle within a gadrooned border. It bears an exquisite crest with the motto 'Forward'. The base with conforming gadrooned rim and a pair of acanthus cast handles on acanthus feet. The arms engraved on dish and lid are for Stewart, From the Highlands to the Lowlands of Scotland, from the Hebrides to the islands of Orkney and Shetland, from Scotland to England and beyond, one clan above all others emerged to lead the nation and reign supreme. Clan Stewart dominated Scotland and then Great Britain as kings and queens for three and a half-centuries.
