A rare opportunity to acquire an exquisite antique porcelain plate in the Sèvres style, crafted in France at the end of the 19th century. This decorative cabinet plate features a rich cobalt blue background (bleu de roi) and is adorned with lavish 24-carat gold gilded ornamentation, showcasing delicate scrolling patterns. The centerpiece displays a beautifully executed hand-painted scene of two elegantly dressed women in 18th-century attire, rendered in soft pastel tones. The artwork bears the signature Gayou, a recognized artist associated with the Limoges factory during the late 19th century. While the base carries a mark resembling Sèvres, this plate is most likely a finely crafted Limoges piece, as suggested by the faint Limoges marking beneath the pseudo-monogram—a common practice in that era to emulate the prestigious Sèvres aesthetic.
