This is a stunning antique French Sevres style Cobalt Blue hand-painted porcelain and ormolu mounted twin handled vase, circa 1880 in date, later converted into a lamp. The large vase shaped porcelain body is painted with gilt-framed panels depicting a classical romantic playful cherubs scene on one side, with a floral panel on the other, on a cobalt blue ground with scrolling leaf handles. The lamp is raised on a shaped square cast ormolu base. Add an elegant touch to any room in your home. Condition: In excellent condition with no chips, cracks or signs of repair, re-wired and tested please see photos for confirmation of condition. Dimensions in cm: Height 55 cm x Width 20 cm x Depth 10 cm Dimensions in inches: Height 1 foot, 10 inches x Width 8 inches x Depth 4 inches Sevres Porcelain traces its roots in France to early craftsmen who had small manufacturing operations in such places as Lille, Rouen, St. Cloud, and most notably Chantilly. It is from Chantilly that a cadre of workers migrated to the Chateau de Vincennes near Paris to form a larger porcelain manufactory in 1738. French King Louis XV, perhaps inspired by his rumoured relationship with mistress...
