It lends itself to perhaps a more classical and professional setting - one can imagine that such an inkstand may have sat on a significant individual's desk, such as a diplomat or perhaps that of a shrewd lawyer. Its generous proportions which are larger than normal inkstands lends itself nicely to the above, exuding a quintessentially British quality of understated yet unwavering boldness and steadiness. The expression "the pen is mightier than the sword" comes to mind upon viewing such an inkstand with a rational yet elegant design - almost as if to reflect the philosophy or as a visual aid to cond...
