Description

'Gulak Tenecir' is the Turkic name for this wonderful pair of dropped earrings. Made during the last quarter of the 19th century by Teke tribes in the Merv Oasis, these earrings were worn by young girls and women in the tribe. Each earring has one table-cut carnelian on gilded and part-gilded silver. Sadly, one of the chain pendants is missing but I keep an eye open for a spare which will come along eventually. Size: 12cm (5") drop including chains x 5cm (2") wide.
