This exceptional piece features the celestial dragon's motif and is a prime example of early 20th-century ceramic artistry. The bowl bears the Portland vase mark on the bottom, alongside pattern number Z 4825, confirming its authenticity and rarity. The exterior has a rich mottled orange lustre with gilt dragons and a gilded edge and base. The interior is finished in an exquisite blue mottled glaze, adorned with gold patterns along the rim and a central dragon design. Such a striking combination of colors was used only on rare occasions, making this an exceptional find. Daisy Makeig-Jones was an influential and innovative designer for Wedgwood, best known for her Fairyland Lustre series. She expertly combined underglaze coloring, overglaze graining, iridescence, and gilded details, creating a distinctive and highly sought-after style in ceramics. The First Ten Lustre Ranges, numbered consecutively from Z4823 to Z4832, consisted of ten different patterns, each with unique combinations of lustre colors.
