Description

Frederick William Jackson (1859-1918) was born at Oldham in 1859. He was the son of an art dealer and photographer and was a member of the Arts Club in 1879, the Limners Club in 1880 and the Manchester Academy of Fine Arts in 1881. He was a founder member of the Staithes group and Art Club and exhibited widely throughout the country. His work is now in important private and public collections and is much sought after. The present painting "Washing Day, Runswick" is a watercolour measuring 11"x 14". It is signed lower right and is framed in the original gilt frame giving an overall size of 20"x 23". On the back is a nice old label for "Chas. A. Jackson," brother of the artist, an art dealer working in Manchester and Oldham.
