Description

This is beyond incredible. Emeralds are typically oiled to seal surface reaching fissures, so to find where the evidence of oiling is negligible makes this a stone of rare quality - and to find one that is also Colombian, and as large as this leaves us floundering in our search for adjectives to do it justice. The bright green of the centre is highlighted by the whiteness of the two 0.30 carat (approx.) old cut diamonds either side. With ornate - but unfussy - detailing in the gallery, leading to a slim 18k yellow gold shank. Accompanied by an emerald report from The Gem & Pearl Laboratory stating the emerald shows evidence of negligible clarity enhancement, and is Colombian in origin. Cut: Emerald cut emerald and old European cut diamonds. Colour: The diamonds are F to G. Clarity: The emerald is eye-clean. The diamonds are VS1 to VS2. Carat: The emerald is 5.68 carat. Each of the diamonds is approximately 0.30 carat. Circa: 1910. Size: P (UK) or 7.5 (US). Free sizing available. Measurements: The emerald is 10.8 x 10.5mm and sits 8.3mm from the finger. Weight: 6.18 grams. Metal: 18k gold. Tested with a Niton DXL Precious Metal Analyzer. Item # 69...
