The drawers are lined in fine oak. The chest has a configuration of 2 short and the 3 graduated drawers under. It stands on shaped bracket feet. The George II burr elm chest has plenty of lovely features, including that it is not too tall therefore making it good to be placed in downstairs settings. It is a lovely golden honey colour and with a good deep patina.
