This is a delightful and rare Georgian silver folding silver fruit fork & fruit knife fitted in a Georgian red leather case. Both knife and fork with engraved mother of pearl handles inset with tiny silver buttons and boasting reeded silver ferrules. Each engraved blade partially hallmarked; ie no maker's mark or date letter, which was very often the case with fruit knives and forks. They are not a pair as such but fit beautiful in their tactile red leather sheath. A rare occurrence. All in very good condition. Hallmarks: Duty Mark (George III) Lion Passant. Dimensions: Fork: 14 cm / 5.4 inches open. 7.5cm / 3 inches closed. Knife: 13cm / 5.1 inches open. Condition: Very good condition. No damage to the mother of pearl.
