1930s Visible pocket watch and chain. The watch has a Swiss stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement is signed Visible, a brand name registered in 1922 by Arnold Bouverat-Jobin of Les Breuleux in Switzerland. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is the gold plated Star model from the English case manufacturer Aaron Dennison. The case is in very nice condition, as is the glass lens. The dial is in lovely condition with blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. The watch comes with a single chain, 31cm long including the T-bar and the clasp. The watch and chain come in a new presentation box.
