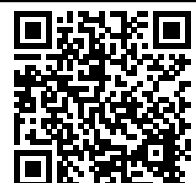
A superb George III / George IV Rosewood Library Writing Table, stamped Gillows of Lancaster to the front of the drawer. With an inset gilt tooled and embossed green-leather writing surface within a gadrooned border above a long mahogany lined drawer on baluster and turned supports with gadrooned Socles, sledge bases and scrolled feet with recessed castors. Structurally sound. Date: c.1795-1825 Dimensions: w: 104 cm. d: 75 cm. h: 74 cm The "Gillows . Lancaster" struck mark is known to have been used on narrow drawer fronts (as with this example) between 1795 & 1825. See (Volume I) p.94-95, Susan E.
