An exclusive contract with a Parisian gallery forced Laloue to use a number of nom de plumes to sign his work to avoid his contractual obligation. These include: Jacques LIEVIN - Eugène GALIANY - Louis DUPUY - M. LENOIR - A. MICHEL - E. KERMANGUY Eugène Galien-laloue was a French artist born in Paris of French-Italian parents. He took his early inspiration painting busy Parisian street scenes of the Belle Epoque era. Later in his career he painted Normandy landscapes and it is from this period that this painting dates.
